Enclosed for your review and approval are the subject work plan addenda. The addenda were prepared to provide a mechanism to address the collection of data needed for the OU 5 Remedial Investigation (RI) Report. The need for the additional data was identified during an evaluation of the unvalidated OU 5 Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study (RI/FS) data set conducted over the past few months.

The addenda have been prepared following the recently implemented Site-Wide Comprehensive Environmental Response Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA) Quality Assurance Project Plan (SCQ) format. In the SCQ format, the addenda are known as Project Specific Plans.

On April 20, at the OU 5 Technical Information Exchange (TIE) meeting, the scopes of work contained in these addenda were presented. In attendance at the TIE were representatives from United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA), Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA), Department of Energy, Fernald Field Office (DOE-FN), Department of Energy, Headquarters (DOE-HQ), and Fernald Environmental Restoration Management Corporation (FERMCO). Therefore, DOE has directed FERMCO to proceed with the field work prior to receipt of formal EPA approval. Immediate implementation is necessary so that the Department of Energy (DOE) can maintain the Consent Agreement schedule milestone of delivering the draft RI report to the U.S. EPA in June 1994.
