The NEPA Program Group has evaluated the proposed action and determined that it constitutes a routine plant service activity. Based on this finding, the proposed interim action is covered by an existing Categorical Exclusion (CX) for "FEMP Routine Maintenance Projects - CY 1991 and 1992 (NEPA Document No. 333). NEPA Document No. 333 (copy attached) was approved by DOE/HQ on November 19, 1991; therefore, the NEPA compliance requirements for this proposed action have been met.


