COMMUNITY MEETING JUNE 22, 1993

Fernald, Ohio -- The U. S. Department of Energy will hold a community meeting on Tuesday evening, June 22, 1993, concerning the Fernald Environmental Management Project (FEMP), at the Plantation, 9960 Dry Fork Road in Harrison, Ohio. The purpose is to discuss progress on cleanup activities at the site.

An exhibit staffed by DOE and FERMCO employees will be open from 6:00 - 7:00 p.m. The meeting begins at 7:00 p.m. DOE spokespersons will discuss project status, as well as other related issues. The U. S. and Ohio Environmental Protection Agencies and Fernald Residents for Environment, Safety and Health (FRESH) will also make brief statements. A group question-and-answer session will follow the presentations.

A transcript of this meeting will be available the week of July 5, 1993, in the FEMP Public Environmental Information Center. The Center is located at 10845 Hamilton-Cleves Road near the FEMP. Hours are Monday and Thursday, 9 a.m. to 8 p.m.; Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday, 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.; and Saturday, 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.
