The U. S. Department of Energy (DOE) announces that the Administrative Record file for Erosion Control at the Inactive Flyash Pile Removal Action is available for public review and comment. The Inactive Flyash Pile was used to collect materials from the FEMP's coal-fired boiler plant and other areas from 1952 until 1968. The Inactive Flyash Pile is located near the bank of Paddys Run Creek, where an increase in erosion has been observed. The removal action involves interim and long term stabilization of the eastern bank of Paddys Run adjacent to the Inactive Flyash Pile to prevent materials from the pile from entering the creek.

An Administrative Record file has been established for this removal action. The file includes documentation relative to the source and nature of potential contamination and the threat of release of contaminants into the environment. Additional documents will include, but are not limited to, analytical data, engineering drawings, and agency correspondence.
