U.S. EPA hereby approves the Final Work Plan Addendum. However, although a significant amount of uranium-contaminated soils have been removed, U.S. EPA maintains that the cleanup levels agreed as part of this Removal Action are interim and must be addressed in further Operable Unit 3 or 5 Remedial Actions.
