This letter is to make you aware that Ohio would like to reprogram the funds budgeted in our Cost Recovery Grant Proposal for the Site Specific Advisory Group. At the time of submittal of this proposal, we were discussing the possibility of the State taking the lead with this group.

At this point in time we are reviewing our Cost Recovery Grant Proposal to determine current needs. Although we do not yet have detailed tasks for reprogramming funds some areas under consideration are, enhanced coordination and management of cleanup programs and increased participation in planning efforts, and regulatory "trouble shooting" in areas such as RCRA/CERCLA integration, coordination with USEPA, etc. In addition, we will probably need to increase funding for travel.

The specific amounts for each of these areas will be negotiated at a later date. If you have any questions please contact me.
