STATE FIRE MARSHAL'S RESPONSE, UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANKS (UST) CLOSURE PLANS FOR UST 14 AND USTs 11, 12 AND 13

Department of Energy, Fernald Field Office (DOE-FN) has received from the State Fire Marshal's (SFM) office responses dated November 1, 1993, (enclosed) on two Underground Storage Tank (UST) closure reports: UST 14 and USTs 11, 12 and 13. For both closure reports, the letters state that the State Fire Marshal's office requires no further action involving corrective actions for each UST system and that no further remediation is required under their regulatory framework. Per discussion with the SFM, DOE-FN can expect a similar response on the closure report for USTs 1, 2, 8, 9 and 10 that was recently submitted. The reports request clean closure under Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Subtitle I and defer to Comprehensive Environmental Response Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA) for additional remediation efforts if determined to be necessary.
