Record U.S. DOE - Fernald", dated January 31, 1989.

This letter provides a response to the referenced correspondence on the Administrative Record for remedial activities at the Feed Materials Production Center (FMPC). The Administrative Record for the FMPC will be compiled and available for public review on-site at the FMPC by no later than June 30, 1989. A copy of the record will be maintained at the Lane Public Library in Hamilton, Ohio.

As part of our active community relations program, the FMPC maintains two public reading rooms. These reading rooms contain information pertinent to FMPC remedial activities. Included are historical environmental health and safety data collected at the facility and RI/FS documentation. These reading rooms have been accessible to the public since the summer of 1985. To augment this community relations program and fulfill procedural requirements of the National Contingency Plan, a separate administrative record will be established and maintained at the FMPC. The Administrative Record will be made available to the public upon request during normal business hours.

Attachment 1 presents a table of contents and index system for the FMPC Environmental Remedial Action Administrative Record. The indexing file will be maintained in a database to facilitate updating and sorting. Attachment 2 provides a listing of the contents of each data base record.

The index file will be updated monthly. The update will include all documents that have been added to the Administrative Record within the preceding month. An updated listing of the contents of the Administrative Record will be provided to USEPA and OEPA on a quarterly basis.

Attachment 3 presents a proposed listing of contents for the Administrative Record. DOE is currently reviewing existing RI/FS related correspondences and community relations information for inclusion in the Administrative Record. The list of contents will be revised as necessary to incorporate additional information as the project progresses. A public notice of the availability of the record will be placed in local newspapers at the time the record is established.
