Dear Mr. Quaider:

This letter is written in response to the June 22, 1993, correspondence from Raymond Hansen, Acting Manager DOE-FEMP, to Paul Pardi, Ohio EPA Hazardous Waste Group Leader. The letter was written in regards to the proposed Satellite Accumulation Areas (SAAs) to be located in Building 15B. The SAAs are to be used for those wastes generated in Building 15, an Analytical Laboratory Building.

The June 22 letter states that the proposed SAAs will be created within 30 days unless objections are received from Ohio EPA staff. The purpose of this correspondence is to inform you that we do have concerns regarding the proposed policy; however, we require additional time to provide you with a final determination.

If the U.S. DOE-FEMP chooses to implement the policy before receiving a final answer from the Ohio EPA, they do so with the understanding that the proposed activities may be determined to be a violation of Ohio's hazardous waste regulations.

We are currently investigating this issue to provide you with the necessary guidance. If you should have any questions or comments, please feel free to contact me at 513-285-6357.
