Dear Mr. Reafsnyder:

During an August 24, 1988, groundwater meeting between the United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA), the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA), and the United States Department of Energy (U.S. DOE), U.S. DOE committed to providing bi-weekly groundwater data transfer to U.S. EPA and OEPA. This transfer was to include raw data that had been received by ASI/IT during the two week period. Since that time, U.S. DOE has failed to submit any additional groundwater data, even though a second groundwater meeting was held on October 28, 1988, and data received since August 24, 1988, was discussed.

All existing remedial investigation (RI) groundwater data, that is in U.S. DOE's or contractor's possession and that has not previously been forwarded to U.S. EPA, should be forward by November 18, 1988. Data reports should then continue every two weeks from that date on.
