
**FEED MATERIALS PRODUCTION CENTER; CLOSURE PLAN FOR THE PAD NORTH OF PLANT 6**

A plan for the closure of a Hazardous Waste Storage Unit (HWSU), the Pad North of Plant 6 at the Feed Materials Production Center (FMPC), has been prepared pursuant to the Ohio Administrative Code, Chapter 3745, and has been forwarded to the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency for review and approval. This action has been taken in recognition of the fact that the State of Ohio received authorization to manage the hazardous waste management program within its boundaries effective June 30, 1989. A copy of the closure plan is forwarded for your information (Enclosure 1).

A revision to the FMPC RCRA Part A Permit application was forwarded to U.S. EPA in March 1989. That application identified a Waste Oil Incinerator at the FMPC Boiler Plant as a HWSU for which a closure plan would be prepared. Subsequent to the transmittal of that Part A application, documentary evidence has been found confirming that the last use of that incinerator occurred in 1979, before the Federal regulations implementing RCRA became effective in November 1980. Therefore, no RCRA closure plan will be prepared for the Waste Oil Incinerator, and the RCRA Part A application will be revised to delete that equipment from the list of HWSUs at the FMPC.

A copy of the documentation confirming the date of last use for the Waste Oil Incinerator is enclosed for your information (Enclosure 2).
