**SUBMITTAL OF REVISION 0.2 TO THE SITEWIDE COMPREHENSIVE ENVIRONMENTAL RESPONSE
COMPENSATION AND LIABILITY ACT QUALITY ASSURANCE PROJECT PLAN**

This letter formally transmits Revision 0.2 to the Sitewide Comprehensive Environmental Response Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA) Quality Assurance Project Plan (SCQ) for the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) approval. This revision is dated May 4, 1994, and reflects changes made following USEPA comments on Revision 0.2, and conditional approval of the revision pending resolution of the USEPA comments.

The Department of Energy, Fernald Field Office (DOE-FN) sent formal comment responses to the USEPA on February 24, 1994, and received an additional round of comments from the USEPA on April 1, 1994. DOE-FN met with USEPA on April 6, 1994, and came to resolution and agreement on all outstanding comments. The agreement entailed development of a Sample Summary Table, and the inclusion of Data Quality Objective (DQO) Logic Flow and DQO Summary Form into each Project Specific Plan. The development of these items was worked with Mr. Al Alwan of the Quality Assurance Section of the USEPA, and agreed to by Mr. Alwan on April 28, 1994. These changes have been included in the enclosed revision and have been indicated in the Summary of Changes as "EPA Comment".

The DOE-FN considers these recent changes related to the SCQ sufficient to achieve final resolution of the outstanding comments. The SCQ should be considered a final approved document once you have had time to review these changes and are satisfied that these changes reflect what was agreed to in the meetings identified above. Included with the enclosures is a signature page which must be signed by the appropriate USEPA representatives. A complete document will be transmitted to you after the signature page is returned to DOE-FN.
