GROUNDWATER ISSUES: Questions about general results of ground water sampling, Round 1 and Round 2; procedures; numbers and locations of wells; rationale for location choices. (well maps)

SURFACE SOILS AND BIOLOGY: Questions about rationale and scope of sampling efforts on crops and garden vegetables; preliminary results of off-site soils and vegetation sampling; comparison of potentially impacted areas with control areas.

REGULATORY ISSUES: Questions about DOE, WMCO, USEPA, OEPA, ASI roles and interactions; requirements. (simplified organizational charts)

RI/FS PROGRAM: Questions about independence of investigation; schedule; how cleanup levels are established; process; environmental issues.

FMPC ENVIRONMENTAL IMPROVEMENTS: Questions about K-65 silos; storm water retention ponds; worker health and safety; further plans.
