2. Administrative Items:

- Trustees expressed no comments/concerns on the draft June 6, 1994 Meeting Summary or the letters to NOAA and ACOE and gave their approval for distribution.

Action to be taken: Trustees agreed to have FERMCO fulfill their administrative role by preparing and distributing future meeting summaries without advance Trustee approval. The summaries will be identified as draft until Trustee approval is obtained. The summaries will be faxed to the Trustees who will give comments/approval orally.

- Ohio EPA was asked how they would like to handle their review, as regulator and trustee, of the Operable Unit 5 RI Report and Feasibility Study (FS) Report.

Action to be taken: OEPA will discuss this matter internally and discuss with the other Trustees at the teleconference.

- The Hanford Trustee Strategy Paper was distributed.

Action to be taken: Trustees will review and discuss at the next teleconference.

- A Trustee teleconference was scheduled for September 22, 1994 from 9:00 to 11:00 a.m. to discuss the proposed agenda items:
  - Brainstorm ideas on streamlining NRDA with the RI/FS process.
  - Identify resource responsibilities for each Trustee.
  - Examine Trustee goals/expectations.
  - Discuss natural resource concerns e.g., migratory birds\*.
  - Review Hanford Trustee Strategy Paper.
  - Pete to discuss his comments from the August 25 meeting.
  - Discuss OEPA's review of documents i.e., submitting comments and being copied on letters/memos.

\*It was noted that Trustees need time to review data in detail before identifying specific natural resource concerns.

- It was suggested that Trustees look at potential integration with the FCTF.

**Action to be taken:** Pete Yerace will discuss Trustee issues with Doug Sarno of the FCTF.

- Trustee input on FEMP site documents e.g., the Natural Resource Management Plan (NRMP) and the Operable Unit 5 ROD, was discussed.

**Action to be taken:** DOE to distribute the NRMP to the Trustees by the September 22 teleconference upon DOE-FN management approval. Further discussion to continue on means to solicit more Trustee input.
