### **SCHEDULE FOR SUBMITTAL OF ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REQUIRED FOR NESHAP APPROVAL**

  - 2) Letter, David Kee, U.S. EPA to James A. Reafsnyder, "Feed Materials Production Center (FMPC) Applications to Modify Pursuant to 40 CFR Part 61", dated December 23, 1989.

The referenced letter (Reference 1) transmitted a Finding of Violation (FOV) for NESHAP at the FMPC. The violations specifically were for failure to submit timely applications to modify pursuant to 40 CFR § 61.07. This letter is to request a schedule for preparation and submittal of NESHAP applications and to reconfirm that WMCO will not operate or commence modification of any NESHAP impacted sources until NESHAP approval has been received.

WMCO is requested to provide a prioritized schedule for submitting applications for all FMPC sources needing NESHAP approval. The following items should be included in the schedule:

- 1) Completion and submittal of the 1988 annual NESHAP compliance demonstration.
- 2) Schedule for resubmittal of the 17 NESHAP applications previously submitted to USEPA. These applications should be submitted in the format of the  $UF_6$  -  $UF_4$  Process #2 Facility application, the information in the most recent draft of the FFCA-NESHAP, and the information requested in the December 23, 1988 letter from Region V denying the first 14 applications (Reference 2).

- 3) Prioritization of any new projects which will need NESHAP approval (D&D Facility, Plant 8 Sump, etc.)

In addition to the above information, WMCO should also provide documentation that the NESHAP/PTO approval is incorporated in the construction schedule for each project, and that all FMPC sources potentially impacted by NESHAP have been identified.

In an effort to expedite this matter, please provide the requested information within two weeks of receipt of this letter. If you have any questions, please contact Jack Craig of my staff at extension 6159.
