FFCA NESHAP AND NESHAP FOV MEETING

- 1) Letter, David Kee, U.S. EPA, to James A. Reafsnnyder, "Feed Materials Production Center (FMPC) Applications to Modify Pursuant to 40 CFR 61", dated December 23, 1989.
 - 2) Letter, James A. Reafsnnyder to M. B. Boswell, "Schedule for Submittal of Additional Information Required for NESHAP Approval", dated April 18, 1989.

A meeting to discuss the FFCA NESHAP and the NESHAP FOV has been tentatively rescheduled for May 23, 1989 in Chicago. Our goal is to come as close to resolution as possible on these NESHAP issues. In order to make the meeting as productive as possible, WMCO is requested to provide some crucial information for the meeting. In addition to any comments you may have on either the FFCA or the FOV, WMCO should provide the following:

- 1) NESHAP annual compliance demonstration for 1988. If the final demonstration is not complete, a draft should be provided for discussion purposes.
- 2) A schedule for the resubmittal of the 17 NESHAP applications for approval previously submitted to U.S. EPA.
- 3) A schedule for the submittal of any other NESHAP applications for approval for sources previously constructed or planned for construction in the near future.
- 4) A listing of all FMPC equipment potentially impacted by the pre-construction approval requirements of NESHAP.

- 5) A complete model NESHAP application for determination of modification and a complete model NESHAP application for approval of modification for the crucible grit blaster (5-085). The applications should be based on the model UF₆-UF₄ Process No. 2 Facility, the December 23, 1988 letter from U.S. EPA (Reference 1), and the most recent version of the FFCA. These applications will serve as the new model for future NESHAP applications, and will be a good basis for discussion at the meeting. Most of these items were requested by my April 18 letter (Reference 2).

Items 1-4 should be provided to my office no later than May 17, 1989. Item #5 should be provided by May 22, 1989 at the latest.
