1993-1995

Dear Owner:

SULFATE: The main purpose of this letter is to inform you of the requirement to monitor for the presence of **Sulfate** in your drinking water during 1995. A sample from each designated entry point to the distribution system must be sent to a state approved sulfate laboratory according to the following schedule: (**Samples are due at the same time as nitrates.**)

PWSID Beginning 01-44 January 1, to June 30, 1995
PWSID Beginning 45-88 July 1, to December 31, 1995

The sulfate monitoring is in addition to the requirements outlined in the standardized chemical monitoring schedule which was issued in November, 1992. Attached is a list of laboratories approved to perform analysis for sulfate in drinking water. Systems which fail to monitor and report sulfate results to the Ohio EPA may receive violations and **may forfeit future sulfate waiver** opportunities. The following is an outline of the remaining scheduled chemical monitoring.

SYNTHETIC ORGANIC CHEMICALS (SOCs): Those ground water systems with PWSID numbers beginning with 61 through 88 that did not receive complete use waivers and complete area wide waivers are scheduled to perform their first quarter of monitoring between January 1 1995 and March 31, 1995.

MCL INORGANICS, All systems are encouraged to refer to their
ASBESTOS, Standardized Monitoring Schedule issued in
RADIOLOGICAL, November 1992 to review these requirements.
NITRATE: All systems are required to monitor for nitrate
every year.

VOLATILE For public water systems that are still monitoring on
ORGANIC a quarterly schedule, a minimum of four **consecutive**
CHEMICALS quarters is required. Public water systems required
(VOCs): to monitor annually in 1995 should consult their
standardized monitoring schedule that was issued
in 1992.

SUMMARY: The above mentioned monitoring requirements are
outlined in chapter 3745-81 of the Ohio
Administrative Code.


