The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) has completed its review of the Removal Action No. 20, Uranyl Nitrate (UNH) Work Plan, Revision 1, and has two comments.

First, U.S. EPA requests that the United States Department of Energy (U.S. DOE) provide further stoichiometric information to further describe the neutralization process. Second, U.S. EPA does not agree with U.S. DOE's procedure to characterize the filter cake. U.S. DOE should collect a sample from every twentieth drum to adequately characterize the filter cake, rather than take only two samples per batch.
