Figures for the individual counties (in Table 2) show nearly equal numbers gaining (48) or losing population (40). The greatest gains were in counties contiguous to the counties containing central cities, indicative of continuing flight from urban and rural locations to suburban residences. Some of the more dramatic examples of growth counties and the increase in population between 1980 and 1990 include:

Clermont	16.9%	Geauga	8.9%
Delaware	24.3%	Holmes	11.7%
Fairfield	10.4%	Pickaway	10.5%

(Franklin County, with a 10.6% growth rate, and Butler County with a 12.6% increase, were exceptions to the central city/county loss pattern.)

The largest losses from 1980 to 1990 were sustained by the following counties:

Belmont	-13.9%	Jefferson	-12.3%
Guernsey	- 7.1%	Mahoning	- 8.5%
Harrison	-11.4%	Monroe	-10.8%

The 1991 estimates show more increases in county populations from 1990 to 1991 than might be anticipated by looking at the 10-year patterns.
