Dear Mr. Quaider:

This letter is in response to your correspondence dated August 16, 1994. In your correspondence you are requesting that the Primary Calciner be reclassified as a Solid Waste Management Unit (SWMU) verses a Hazardous Waste Management Unit (HWMU).

After review of your submittal, Ohio EPA concurs that the East Eimco Filter Cake would not cause the Primary Calciner to be classified as a HWMU. However, at this time, Ohio EPA does not concur with your position that Box Furnace Ash could not have been placed in the Primary Calciner. To assist us in making a final determination I am requesting that you submit to this office a copy of the consumption records which are in question for the Box Furnace. After review of requested records Ohio EPA will make a final determination regarding the reclassification of the Primary Calciner.
