**REMOVAL ACTION #9 MIXED WASTE PROJECT**

This letter is to confirm your agency's verbal approval of the U.S. Department of Energy's (DOE) plan to initiate a Mixed Waste Disposal Project under Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980 (CERCLA) Removal Action #9. The scope of this project includes the disposition of approximately 350 drums of mixed wastes at the Envirocare facility near Clive, Utah. The Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, 1976 (RCRA) waste classification of the wastes vary; however, all exhibit specific hazardous characteristics ranging from D018 through D043 or are F-listed wastes with listed hazardous constituent concentrations below Land Disposal Restriction treatment standards. This project does not involve waste treatment. This project does include preparing the subject drums for shipment, loading the palletized drums onto trucks, and transporting to the Envirocare disposal facility. The scope of this project is consistent with the Removal Site Evaluation and Action Memorandum Addendum for Removal Action #9.

The project will be initiated in the first week of March 1995, and will take approximately four weeks to complete. The project will be governed by the following procedures which have or will be formally incorporated into the Removal Action #9 Work Plan via the annual update process:
