You are invited to attend the next in a series of U.S. Department of Energy community meetings about clean-up efforts at the Feed Materials Production Center (FMPC) at Fernald, Ohio. The meeting, focusing on the Remedial Investigation and Feasibility Study underway, will be held on Tuesday evening, February 20, 1990 at Stricker's Grove near Ross, Ohio.

Fernald has been in the headlines since DOE held the last RI/FS community meeting in October. Issues such as monitoring wells and new results raise a lot of questions. This meeting provides an opportunity for you to get the facts and answers to your questions.

Our staff will be available to answer questions from 6:00 to 7:00 p.m. Formal presentations will begin at 7:00 p.m. and will be followed by time for questions. The presentations will focus on sampling activities and results, the direction of long- and short-term cleanup plans, and introduce the Environmental Impact Statement that will be based on RI/FS findings.

I realize that your time is valuable, and that there are several meetings this winter to discuss Fernald issues. However, these meetings provide you the opportunity to learn specifically about the progress being made on the cleanup of the site. I hope you can join us.
