Dear Neighbor:

I would like to invite you to attend the next in a series of U.S. Department of Energy community meetings about cleanup efforts at the Feed Materials Production Center (FMPC) at Fernald, Ohio. This meeting, focusing on the site's major environmental study -- the Remedial Investigation and Feasibility Study - will be held on Tuesday evening, May 22, 1990, at Stricker's Grove south of Ross.

Our staff will be available to answer questions at technical displays prior to the meeting, from 6 to 7 p.m. The formal meeting will start at 7:00 p.m. We will provide an update of activities since our February community meeting, the latest environmental sampling activities and results, and the direction and status of long- and short-term cleanup. We will also discuss our plans for managing the uranium contamination associated with the South Plume. (The report documenting these plans is available for public review in the FMPC Administrative Record files, located in the FMPC Administration Building and in the Lane Public Library in Hamilton.) As always, there will be ample time to answer your questions. Both the U.S. EPA and Ohio EPA will join DOE for the meeting.

I realize that your time is valuable, and that there are several meetings this spring that focus on issues regarding the FMPC. This meeting is your opportunity to learn specifically about our recent progress along the path to site cleanup. Because this will be my first community meeting since I became FMPC Site Manager, I am looking forward to seeing you there.
