This letter is in response to your correspondence dated February 2, 1987 regarding the project noted above. As you have requested, my staff has reviewed our files for information pertaining to the study area noted above. A large number of archaeological sites have been recorded in the Ohio Archaeological Inventory in the area surrounding the facility (see enclosed map). Two archaeological surveys have been conducted near FMPC. A map showing the survey areas has also been enclosed. The first, "Archaeological Sampling in the New Haven Trough, Hamilton County, Ohio" was completed in 1986 by Robert A. Genheimer of the Miami Purchase Association for Historic Preservation and Thomas W. Gatus of Association for Anthropological Research, Inc. Another survey, "Fort Ancient Chronology and Settlement Evaluation in the Great Miami Valley, Part I" was conducted in 1986 by Elizabeth Scheurer of the Cincinnati Museum of Natural History. Reports of both of these surveys are on file in the Archaeology Laboratory of the Ohio Historical Society, 1985 Velma Avenue, Columbus, Ohio. There is no documentation of a survey of Paddy's Run. However, the Miami Purchase Association has been inventoring sites in the area for several years. These site forms are also located at the Ohio Historical Society.


