Ohio EPA has reviewed DOE's "Submittal of Updated Information for Uranyl Nitrate Hexahydrate Neutralization Project Removal Action Work Plan" submitted on June 2, 1995 and the "Uranyl Nitrate Hexahydrate Neutralization Project - Processing Sequence" submitted on June 9, 1995. Ohio EPA approves DOE's request to change the UNH Processing Schedule defined in Order #1 of the Director's Final Findings & Orders issued on December 27, 1994 as well as the additional changes to the UNH Removal Action Work Plan. Ohio EPA's approval is based upon DOE's intent to complete removal and treatment of the UNH in all tanks by September 28, 1995, the reduced number of leaks, leak containment activities, and recent DOE/FERMCO actions to transfer and/or neutralize UNH. Ohio EPA is open to additional revisions to the sequencing during operations as long as DOE obtains Ohio EPA approval prior to initiating such an action.
