Comment: This table lists waste management and disposition of Plant 7 material only in terms of pounds of steel, concrete etc. The Ohio EPA would like to see data on the Plant 7 waste material in terms of volume (i.e. cubic yards of steel, concrete etc.). This information is valuable since the proposed on-site disposal cell capacity will be designed in terms of cubic yards of waste. Also, this information will aid in determining, and verifying the volume of OU3 material to be disposed of in the on-site disposal cell. All future OU3 D&D projects reports should also list waste material in this manner.

Comment: This section states that verification soil samples were to be taken during the removal action of Plant 7, however, these samples were not collected due to a change in demolition techniques. While modifications from a work plan do occur during field activities, both regulatory agencies need to be informed prior to any deviation from the approved work plan.
