The Ohio EPA has reviewed the documentation you submitted to demonstrate that the Uranyl Nitrate Hexahydrate (UNH) System's tanks (with the exception of Tanks F1-25 and F1-26) have been properly decontaminated. The Ohio EPA concurs that the tanks listed in the table attached to your October 6, 1995 letter have been properly decontaminated as required by Order 5 of the December 27, 1994 Directors' Final Findings and Orders. In addition, the October 6, 1995 letter and attachment satisfy the reporting requirements for these tanks as required by Order 5.

Please submit a report for Tanks F1-25 and F1-26 at the time the Nitric Acid/Residual Waste Project has been completed and the tanks have been properly decontaminated.
