I have reviewed your letter and enclosures submitted October 31, 1995. The referenced letter requests Ohio EPA concurrence with DOE-FEMP's determination that the Experimental Treatment Facility (HWMU 51) should be reclassified to a Solid Waste Management Unit (SWMU). Upon review of the analytical data provided, it appears that hazardous waste had not been treated nor stored in this unit. Therefore, Ohio EPA concurs with DOE's determination.
