Dear Owner:

For the purpose of the surface water treatment rules contained in Chapter 3745-81 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), the Division of Drinking and Ground Waters (DDAGW) has conducted a survey and evaluation of the raw water source(s) of your public water system. The survey and evaluation covered well construction, sanitary well isolation, and history of bacterial contamination and waterborne disease outbreaks. As a result of this evaluation and a subsequent engineering review of your water sources' susceptibility to biological contamination, the Division has recommended that the Director of the Environmental Protection Agency, in accordance with Rule 3745-81-76 of the OAC, designate your water source(s) as ground water. Ground water and surface water are defined in paragraphs (Z) and (EEE) of Rule 3745-81-01 of the OAC, respectively.

This letter is your notice of the Director's Finding which formalizes the designation of each of your water source(s) which have been approved and are in service as of the date of this letter as ground water, under Rule 3745-81-76 of the OAC, effective on the date shown above. The water sources designation worksheet and other information on which this designation is based and which identify your individual water sources are available for your review at either your Ohio EPA district office or at the Ohio EPA's Division of Drinking and Ground Waters office in Columbus.

Section 119.06 of the Ohio Revised Code provides that within thirty (30) days of issuance of this proposed finding, you may request a hearing before the Director. Requests for a hearing before the Director must be in writing and filed with the Hearing Clerk, 1800 WaterMark Drive, Columbus, Ohio 43215-1099. At that hearing you may address those issues you believe to be relevant to the designation of your water source, be represented by counsel, and present evidence and witnesses.

Your water system must continue to comply with all rules of the OAC which apply to water systems which obtain water from sources which are designated ground water. Also, the Director may redesignate a water source as surface water at any time additional information indicates that redesignation is appropriate.
