The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) has completed its review of the United States Department of Energy's (U.S. DOE) letter concerning the proposed modification of the KC-2 Warehouse/Well 67 sampling program.

Since HSL metals analysis are consistent with previous results and below U.S. EPA maximum contaminant levels, U.S. EPA concurs with U.S. DOE's recommendation to reduce the well sampling frequency from a semi-annual to an annual basis. Annual sampling will continue until the well is decommissioned.
