The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) has completed its review of the United States Department of Energy's (U.S. DOE) Removal Action 9: technology specific work plan for waste segregation.


The work plan describes the objectives and scope of work necessary to segregate mixed waste materials currently stored at the site into eleven waste categories, each of which will include a waste stream to be treated by a specific chemical process.

Although the work plan conforms with U.S. EPA guidance some minor clarification is required. Therefore, U.S. EPA approves the work plan pending submittal of responses to comments and changed pages incorporating adequate responses to U.S. EPA's attached comments. U.S. DOE must submit responses to comments and changed pages within thirty (30) days receipt of this letter.
