Pursuant to Section V of the Director's Final Findings and Orders (DF&O), this letter is the Department of Energy, Fernald Area Office's (DOE-FN) and the Fernald Environmental Restoration Management Corporation's (FERMCO) Request for Withdrawal of Closure Plans/Closure Plan Information and Data (CPID) packages previously submitted to the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA) for the Hazardous Waste Management Units (HWMU) identified in Attachment A of the DF&O.

The following HWMUs will also be closed under the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act/Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (CERCLA/RCRA) process, in accordance with the DF&O. Although the Fernald Environment Management Project (FEMP) is not required to obtain a hazardous waste facility installation and operation permit for the hazardous waste storage activities as

outlined in Order 9, the FEMP will continue to use these HWMU storage units in the course of completing the Records of Decision (ROD) and for ongoing waste management operations. These Hazardous Waste Management Units were identified in the FEMP RCRA Part B Permit Application, Revision 2.1.
