**RE: 1995 TRI SUBMISSION**

The Ohio EPA Division of Air Pollution Control coordinates the Toxic Release Inventory Program. The TRI reports are submitted under the Ohio Right-To-Know Law and the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act of 1986, also known as SARA Title III Section 313. Under the TRI reporting requirements, facilities are required to report to both the U.S. EPA and the Ohio EPA. If a Form R is not received by both the U.S. EPA and the Ohio EPA on or before the reporting deadline, the facility is considered out of compliance and subject to enforcement action.

After comparing the Ohio EPA's data with the U.S. EPA's data, it was discovered that your facility did file with the U.S. EPA, but not with the Ohio EPA for calendar year 1995. Please check your records, to determine if your reports had been submitted to the Ohio EPA for calendar year 1995.
