According to Ohio EPA records, on September 30, 1991, the Director of the Ohio EPA approved a closure plan for US DOE-FEMP. The plan concerned the HWMU's #31/32, bulk storage tanks T-5 & T-6 at the facility. The Ohio EPA has also received certification documents stating that the hazardous waste storage tanks had been closed according to the specifications in the approved closure plan. Ohio EPA District Office personnel completed a closure inspection and a review of documents pertaining to the storage tanks on May 29, 1996.

Based on this inspection and review, the Ohio EPA has determined that the former hazardous waste storage tanks have been closed in accordance with the approved closure plan and Rules 3745-55-11 through 3745-55-15 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). US DOE-FEMP, remains a treatment, storage & disposal facility (TSDF).
