



### CLARIFICATION ON THE STATUS OF REMOVAL ACTION 30 - KC2 WAREHOUSE/WELL 67

This letter is issued to clarify the status of Removal Action 30 - KC2 Warehouse/Well 67 in order to close the Administrative Record (AR) file for the Removal Action. A September 27, 1993, letter from the Department of Energy (DOE) to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) and Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA) stated that the Removal Action was terminated. The Record of Decision (ROD) for Operable Unit 5 (OU5) states that sampling and monitoring of the well will continue until the structure is demolished and the well is plugged and abandoned.

Since Well 67 has not yet been plugged, a final report has not been prepared. However, all other documents required by the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA) and the National Contingency Plan (NCP) are in the AR file for this Removal Action. As stated above, sampling and monitoring will continue. Final measures to protect human health and the environment from the minimal risks associated with the well will be performed under the Operable Unit 3 (OU3) and OU5 remedial activities.
