



DOE Extends Vitrification Pilot Plant Program Schedule

Operations for the Fernald Vitrification Pilot Plant are now expected to be completed by Oct. 22, 1997, 17 months later than previously estimated. The schedule extension does not affect DOE's plan to complete the Fernald cleanup in 10 years.

The Vitrification Pilot Plant Program is being conducted as part of the remediation of Operable Unit 4 at Fernald. Operable Unit 4 includes Silos 1 and 2 (K-65 Silos), Silo 3 (metal oxide silo), and Silo 4, which is empty. The K-65 Silos contain radium-bearing, low-level radioactive wastes dating back to the 1950s. Silo 3 contains dried uranium-bearing wastes.

Vitrification is a new technology. The Vitrification Pilot Plant Program is a test project being conducted prior to the implementation of a full-scale system to obtain detailed design, cost and performance data. Radioactive waste from Fernald's silos will be treated in the full-scale facility once construction is complete. The radioactive waste material will be superheated and encapsulated in glass (vitrification). In December 1994, a Record of Decision (ROD) for Operable Unit 4 was approved by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). The ROD calls for removing the materials from Silos 1, 2 and 3 and treating them by solidifying the waste and trapping the radioactive elements in a glass-like substance in a vitrification facility at the Fernald site.

The extension is necessary for several reasons, including: late delivery of the pilot plant's most critical element, a high temperature "melter," which has resulted in a five-month delay of plant systems and components supporting the melter. Original assumptions for the amount of time the melter would be operational were overly optimistic. Under the new assumptions, operations will be extended from three months to 12 months. The detailed scope of design for the project was underestimated, and some design errors resulted in construction rework.

DOE remains confident in the project's capabilities and expects the project to progress despite the schedule extension. Lessons learned from this project will be used in construction of the full-scale system, which should be completed by Jan. 29, 1996. The Vitrification Pilot Plant project will be conducted in two phases.



During the first phase, approximately 20 to 30 metric tons of non-radioactive, surrogate materials will be used to demonstrate vitrification. Testing of the non-radioactive material is expected to begin by March 15, 1996. During the second phase, radioactive materials to be retrieved from Fernald's Silos 2 and 3 will be used.

Fernald Managers Brief Congressional Representatives

On Nov. 6, DOE Fernald Area Office Director Jack Craig, FERMCO President Don Ofte and FERMCO Vice President Mike Yates traveled to Washington, D.C., to brief House of Representative and Senate staff members about the status of Fernald cleanup progress.

Craig gave an overview of the 10-year accelerated cleanup plan, the Fernald Citizens Task Force recommendations, and safety and cost reduction initiatives. Ofte discussed FERMCO's safety performance, remediation progress and the accelerated cleanup path forward. Yates explained the 10-year accelerated cleanup plan and remediation.

Fernald Work Continued During Government Shutdown



Although many federal agencies were adversely affected during the recent government shutdown, work at Fernald continued, despite the absence of approved appropriations for fiscal year 1996.

All DOE Fernald Area Office Programs could have operated through November before any shutdowns or employee furloughs would have been required.

Fernald Completes Treatment of Thorium Nitrate

Almost 6,000 gallons of thorium nitrate, a contaminated acid waste stream, have been treated and solidified safely in full compliance with environmental regulations. Disposition of the acid eliminates a potential threat to workers and the environment and clears the path for decontamination and dismantlement activities to continue without disruption.

The final rinse of the thorium nitrate tank was completed Nov. 9, less than two months after Chem-Nuclear, FERMCO's subcontractor, began processing the material and six months after FERMCO and Chem-Nuclear began designing the treatment system. During the project, 369 drums of solidified thorium cement were generated.

The thorium nitrate is the third of four contaminated acid waste streams to have been treated at Fernald since June 1995. Other sources include: 205,000 gallons of uranyl nitrate hexahydrate; 6,000 gallons of hydrofluoric acid; and approximately 21,000 gallons of nitric acid. The project is 75 percent complete.

Radon Inversion Occurred Nov. 6

On Nov. 6, between midnight and 1 a.m., radon concentrations exceeded limits at an exclusion fence around Fernald's K-65 silos. Environmental monitoring devices along the fence detected concentrations between 131 picocuries of radon per liter of air (pCi/l) to 145 pCi/l. DOE's limit is 100 pCi/l.

Data indicated a particularly strong meteorologic inversion while the elevated radon concentrations were recorded. Higher radon concentrations are typically recorded during strong inversions, which can form at ground level when there is cooling below or heating above an atmospheric area and the air is calm. Inversions are related to atmospheric stability and the rate of change in temperature with height. The occurrence was recorded as a loggable event. Fernald's annual Site Environmental Report, available at the PEIC, contains detailed information about radon.

Airborne Uranium Emissions at Fernald Continue to Decline

Airborne uranium emissions from the Fernald site continued to decline in 1994, as highlighted in the annual Fernald Site Environmental Report, which was issued Nov. 13. The report presents sampling data for air, water, soil, sediment, vegetation, fish and other media which are collected throughout the year as part of the Fernald environmental monitoring program.

Airborne uranium emissions at Fernald have decreased since production activities at the site ended in 1989. During 1994, the site released an estimated 1.3 kilograms (2.9 pounds) of uranium. As environmental restoration and waste management efforts proceed at Fernald, environmental monitoring programs remain in place to track progress in reducing potential contamination of the environment and to calculate the potential radiation dose to the public as a result of Fernald cleanup activities.



In 1994, the dose to the maximally exposed individual was approximately 0.7 millirem, or less than 1 percent of the limit established by the International Commission on Radiological Protection. The maximally exposed individual is a hypothetical person assumed to live next to the Fernald site, eat only locally produced fruits and vegetables, and drink water from a local well.

Radon Readings Slightly Higher Due to More Conservative Measurements

In 1994, Fernald personnel used a more conservative methodology consistent with that used by the National Council on Radiation Protection for estimating radon dose to the public.

The radon dose for 1994 was calculated at 576 millirem, slightly higher than the 454 millirem dose for 1993. These dose estimates include the approximately 200 millirem attributable to background levels of radon. By using a more conservative methodology, scientists can ensure the reported dose is the highest possible dose anyone may have received as a result of the Fernald site.

DOE seeks to limit radon concentrations at its facilities to below 3 picocuries per liter (pCi/L). At the Fernald fence line, measurements in 1994 were approximately 0.8 pCi/L, higher than the 0.6 pCi/L measured in 1993, but still well below the DOE limit.


For comparison, in 1994 some annual average background concentrations of radon (concentrations at off-site areas in the Cincinnati area) ranged from 0.8 to 1.3 pCi/L. At low environmental levels, radon concentrations can fluctuate significantly from location to location, as well as from year to year.

Uranium in Fernald's Liquid Effluents Decrease

Uranium in all liquid effluent discharged from Fernald decreased from 583 kilograms (1,283 pounds) in 1993 to an estimated 458 kilograms (1,013 pounds) in 1994. Contaminated groundwater pumped from the aquifer under the site and the surrounding area contributed to the total.

Extraction wells, installed south of the site to prevent further migration of uranium contamination, began operating in August 1993. The contaminated water is returned to the site for monitoring and treatment and is then discharged to the Great Miami River. Fernald's uranium discharges to the river decreased from 474 kilograms (1,044 pounds) in 1993 to 351 kilograms (772 pounds) in 1994. Of the uranium discharged to the river in 1994, 147 kilograms (323 pounds) were from South Plume pumping.

FERMCO Employees Recognized for Safety Achievement

Nov. 17, FERMCO logged 3 million consecutive safe work hours with no lost workday accidents. During this period, which began in March, several complex cleanup projects were in progress, including the uranyl nitrate hexahydrate (UNH) transfer and neutralization project and Plant 4 decontamination and dismantling activities. FERMCO used its own corporate funds to purchase turkeys for all employees through Ross IGA.

Joint Fire District Being Discussed With Local Townships

With DOE concurrence, FERMCO has approached Ross, Morgan, Crosby and Colerain townships about forming a joint fire district to enhance emergency response capabilities. For example, Fernald is completely staffed during the day and has a limited crew during the evenings; the opposite is true for local communities. Resources could be pooled; however, the existing fire departments or life squads would not be replaced.

DOE Awards Contract for Hazardous Materials Response Training of Fire Departments Along DOE Truck Routes

DOE has awarded a contract to the International Association of Firefighters (IAFF) to provide hazardous materials response training for fire departments along DOE's truck transportation routes. All fire departments in Fernald's vicinity will be included. The purpose is to reduce potential risks associated with radioactive and hazardous wastes in the event of a transportation-related accident, leak or spill. Emergency response trainers will receive special instruction and materials to assist them in responding to potential transportation-related emergencies involving radioactive or hazardous waste from selected DOE sites. IAFF is an experienced authority in developing training for emergency response personnel, who have unique responsibilities with these types of emergencies. IAFF has trained over 400,000 firefighters in the United States.

Leases for Cattle Grazing on East Side of Site Will Terminate

Leases enabling cattle to graze on the eastern portion of the Fernald site will be terminated in February 1996. Currently, there is no reason to discontinue leases which permit the cattle to graze on the western portion of the site. Historically, DOE has renewed grazing leases every five years. However, from now on, lease agreements will be negotiated on a year-to-year basis to provide more flexibility should construction schedules change and access to parts of the site may be required. Fernald personnel will continue to access to these areas, as needed.

Comments on Disposition of Prehistoric Remains Due Dec. 18

Public comments on the environmental assessment (EA) regarding disposition of prehistoric remains associated with the public water supply project are due Dec. 18. The EA was prepared pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act, which requires DOE to consider impacts to humans and the environment as a result of the project. Reburial of the remains on Fernald property is the preferred alternative being considered.

Operable Unit Project Descriptions Change in Realignment

To permit more efficient performance of remedial design/remedial action at Fernald, FERMCO has changed how the operable units are divided among technical teams, which had previously been referred to as CERCLA/RCRA Units (CRUs) 1 through 5.

The Fernald site is divided into five sections known as operable units. Each operable unit is defined by its location or the potential for similar technologies to be used in the ultimate cleanup. The CRU management approach has been replaced with five fully integrated "project organizations" to focus on successful planning and execution of remedial activities for discrete segments of Fernald's total project scope. All agreements and project documentation expectations with the regulatory agencies remain in effect.

DOE Community Meeting to be Held Dec. 12



Public Workshop on Waste Pit Remedial Action Design Held Nov. 14

A public workshop was held Nov. 14 to discuss remedial design activities in support of the waste pits remedial action project. Results of the recently completed Dewatering Excavation Evaluation Program (DEEP) were presented at the meeting, and that information is incorporated in the preliminary design package. Also discussed were the remedial design/remedial action schedule and opportunities for public involvement during the project.


Final Report on Alternative Radium Sources Expected by Dec. 15

By Dec. 15, DOE expects to receive the University of Cincinnati's (UC) final investigation report on alternative radium sources which could be used as feedstocks for the production of medical isotopes. Scientists are currently evaluating the potential for using Fernald's K-65 silo residues. In addition, the scope of work has been finalized for UC to study potential processes for extracting the radium from vitrified K-65 waste.



Regulators' Comments Received on Operable Unit 3 Documents

In early November, DOE received U.S. EPA's and Ohio EPA's comments on the *Operable Unit 3 Remedial Investigation and Feasibility Study Report* and the *Proposed Plan for the Operable Unit 3 Final Remedial Action*. Generally, the documents were well-received by the regulators. Comment resolution and resubmittal to the regulators will be completed in December.



Draft Plant 1 Complex Implementation Plan Submitted to EPA for Review


In early November, DOE submitted the draft *Plant 1 Complex -- Phase I Implementation Plan for Above-Grade Decontamination and Dismantlement* to U.S. and Ohio EPAs to review. The implementation plan summarizes project-specific design and field activities planned for decontamination and dismantlement of seven structures and a portion of an eighth structure located within the Plant 1 complex. The regulators' comments are expected within 60 days. The document is available at the PEIC.

Draft-final Operable Unit 5 Record of Decision Sent to U.S. EPA

On Nov. 10, the draft-final Operable Unit 5 Record of Decision (ROD) was issued to U.S. EPA for approval. This document contains responses to U.S. EPA and Ohio EPA comments on the draft ROD, which was submitted to U.S. EPA Aug. 2.

The draft-final ROD was modified to reflect EPA comments. The draft-final Operable Unit 5 ROD is available at the PEIC. Also included in the ROD are responses to public comments on the Operable Unit 5 Proposed Plan. Provided as part of the ROD, a stand-alone appendix contains responses to each individual public comment received during the comment period, which was conducted May 1 through June 30, 1995.

Responses to a select number of public comments were modified from their original version to incorporate necessary revisions to U.S. EPA and Ohio EPA comments. These necessary revisions are focused on the receipt of hazardous waste into the on-site disposal facility and establishment of an uranium-based discharge limit to the Great Miami River.




Teachers Develop Resource for Others During Education Outreach Program
