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Environmental Management Project

What is a.....
Community Reuse Organization (CRO)?

- A group of individuals to determine and sponsor community led actions to offset local impacts as a result of downsizing and eventual closure of DOE federal facilities, such as Fernald.
- Community transition planning and establishment of a CRO fall under Section 3161 of the *National Defense Authorization Act of 1993*, which is administered by the DOE Office of Worker and Community Transition.

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Environmental Management Project

Fernald CRO

The Fernald CRO will:

- advise DOE on community transition and economic development issues;
- make specific future land use recommendations within the parameters of the Fernald Citizens Task Force's recommendations;
- advise on the disposition of excess government property.

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Fernald CRO Membership

Fernald's CRO will be a diverse mix of local residents, including:

- representatives of business and financial institutions;
- planning and economic development specialists;
- Fernald employees;
- local elected officials;
- educators;
- FRESH;
- Fernald Citizens Task Force members.

Program Background

- ◆ Program was created by Section 3161 of The National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 1993.
- ◆ Primary effort to assist the work force, but included authority to provide “local impact assistance” to communities affected by the change in the work force.
- ◆ Since FY 1993, DOE has provided approximately \$138 million for community transition assistance to eleven affected sites.
- ◆ In FY 1996, DOE will provide about \$40 million for community transition.
- ◆ Assistance has resulted in 4,100 new or retained jobs, and 329 new or expanded businesses; by the year 2001, project over 20,000 jobs and 1,000 businesses.

The DOE Approach to Community Transition

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- ◆ It is a local process--rely on the DOE sites and the Community Reuse Organization (CRO) for program direction.
- ◆ It is a public process--involve all the stakeholders
- ◆ Recognize that the work force, not the real estate is the most valuable asset.
- ◆ Build on the continuing mission while supporting diversification.

The Process for Community Transition Assistance

- ◆ First, form a Community Reuse Organization (CRO)
 - Speak with one voice for the community
 - Be inclusive
 - coordinate with existing economic development organizations
 - coordinate with the DOE site
- ◆ The Office of Worker and Community Transition can help with a start up grant (typically up to \$100,000 over 2 years)

The Process (cont.)

- Second, develop a community transition plan
 - Assure public involvement
 - Identify strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, and threats
 - Strategic look at the communities' futures
 - Helps develop a focus on the high success options
- ◆ The Office of Worker and Community Transition has funded these plans at levels of \$250,000 to \$500,000

How Plans are Approved

- ◆ CRO develops and submits to DOE Field Organization
- ◆ Reviewed by Field and Office of Worker and Community Transition
- ◆ Field Organization submits to Headquarters
- ◆ Economic Development Administration Review and Peer Review
- ◆ Office of Worker and Community Transition reviews plans and inputs from Peer Review and the Economic Development Administration, makes funding decisions
- ◆ Funds sent to Field Organizations with approval letter
- ◆ Field Organizations prepare financial documents (grant, cooperative agreement, etc..) and disperse funds.
- ◆ Monitoring and feed back on performance

Program Evaluation

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- ◆ Program activities are expected to be tied to the strategies identified in the plan
- ◆ DOE has entertained programs from \$400,000 to \$5,000,000 in a given year
- ◆ All sites do not receive funds every year
- ◆ Focus is on concrete results and rewarding successful past performance


- ◆ Technical assistance and loan funds for new businesses.
- ◆ Entrepreneurial Training.
- ◆ Low-cost access to facilities and equipment for new private ventures.
- ◆ Transfer of technologies.
- ◆ Incubator sites at the facilities.
- ◆ Development of off-site training and technology transfer centers.

- ◆ Information exchange programs.
- ◆ Metal recycling program.
- ◆ Procurement assistance (local firm preference).
- ◆ Minor rehabilitation and off-site infrastructure projects.
- ◆ Property sales (two sites).
- ◆ Administrative and planning activities.

Community Reuse Organization

Within the next decade, the Fernald site will be downsizing and eventually closing after environmental remediation is complete. Fernald area citizens and employees are forming a new community group to address economic development opportunities following remediation of the Fernald site.

This new community group, the Community Reuse Organization (CRO), will advise the Department of Energy (DOE) on local economic development issues and community planning for the future. Specifically, the CRO will focus on the following issues:

- specific community planning issues;
- economic development and work force issues;
- planning for distribution of Fernald's capital assets.

The CRO's recommendations will build upon the broad land use recommendations provided by the Fernald Citizens Task Force. Last summer, the Task Force recommended to DOE that specific uses of the Fernald property should be determined closer to the actual time of reuse, and by the people most impacted by that use.

CRO MEMBERSHIP

Anyone who is interested in volunteering time and energy to address Fernald economic development issues may apply for membership. The CRO will be a diverse group comprised of local residents; elected officials; representatives from educational, local business and financial institutions; Fernald employees; economic development agencies; the Fernald Citizens Task Force; the Fernald Residents for Environmental, Safety and Health, and other public interest groups.

CRO APPLICATION PROCESS

To ensure the formation process is fair, open and inclusive of all interests, FERMCO -- DOE's contractor for managing Fernald cleanup -- and DOE have contracted with Maria Curro Kreppel to serve as CRO convener. She will meet with the communities and Fernald employees, develop the CRO charter and operating procedures, and ultimately recommend to DOE the CRO's membership and chair. Kreppel is an associate professor at the University of Cincinnati's College of Applied Science. She has served as vice provost for Faculty Affairs, and was visiting dean for Academic and Student Affairs at Chatfield College. She brings experience in forming organizations, with a special focus on organizational communication and dispute resolution.


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

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
