### **SUBMITTAL OF THE CHEM-NUCLEAR SYSTEMS CORPORATION WORK PLAN AND QUALITY ASSURANCE PLAN**

Enclosed, for your perusal, are the documents submitted by the subcontractor, Chem-Nuclear Systems (CNS), who is one of the four Proof of Principle (POP) testing contractors to the Fluor Daniel Fernald, Inc. (FDF). As per the contract requirement, Chem-Nuclear Systems was required to submit the work plan and the Quality Assurance (QA) plan for FDF approval prior to initiation of the testing at Chem-Nuclear's facility. Enclosed documents were reviewed and conditionally approved by FDF. FDF has provided conditional approval of the Work Plan so that CNS could proceed as scheduled with its bench scale development activities, while final clarifications to sections of the Work Plan associated with the 72 Hour Demonstration Run could be incorporated into the document. As the revisions are made to the Work Plan, the copies will be available for your perusal.

Upon completion of the POP testing per the contract, CNS will be submitting the final report to FDF for review and approval. At that time, as per our agreement, the final report will be submitted for your review and comment. The performance period of the contract is 48 weeks and this schedule is on the critical path to the completion of the revised Feasibility Study/Proposed Plan (FS/PP) and Record of Decision (ROD) Amendment.
