The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) has completed its review of the United States Department of Energy's (U.S. DOE) proposed changed pages to the Impacted Material Placement Plan (IMPP) for the On-Site Disposal Facility (OSDF).

The changed pages were based on earlier discussions between the Agencies reflecting lessons learned by U.S. DOE during the first year of OSDF operations.
