SUBJECT: U.S. DOE-FEMP - RETURN TO COMPLIANCE (RTC)

Dear Sirs:

The Ohio EPA Division of Hazardous Waste Management issued a Notice of Violation (NOV) to U.S. DOE-FEMP on November 10, 1999. The NOV was issued following U.S. DOE-FEMP's self report detailing the discovery of two (2) storage containers (metal boxes) which had leaked mixed waste (waste waters) on-site.

DOE-FEMP's response to the NOV was received December 3, 1999. The agency subsequently requested additional information as a follow-up to the facility's description of certain corrective actions.

This office has completed a review of facility information submitted as a result of the NOV, and considers that U.S. DOE-FEMP has corrected the violations and implemented corrective actions designed to prevent a re-occurrence of the violations cited in the November 10, 1999 NOV.
