This letter also serves as a written record of verbal interpretations of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) that were discussed with Nancy Weatherup. It is Ohio EPA's interpretation that the modification to the submitted plan to change the method of applying the lifts of soil is insignificant. The proposed change consisted of applying the lifts with a 'dozer instead of with a grader. This interpretation is based on the fact that the OAC only specifies details of compaction of the liner components, not how the components are spread.
