- Figure 2-1 does not show the perched water zones requiring remediation as stated on page 2-5, line 10.
- Delete the reference to the use of hay bales to minimize sediment deposition on page 2-10, line 18. Please refer to "Rainwater and Land Development, Ohio's Standards for Stormwater Management, Land Development and Urban Stream Protection", 2nd Edition, 1996, Ohio Department of Natural Resources (commonly referred to as Rainwater and Land Development) for guidance on adequate sediment control measures.
