The purpose of this letter is to request that ASCII data files be included with several of the deliverables that are due on October 1, 1996 from the Aquifer Restoration Project. These deliverables are as follows:

- Injection Demonstration
- South Plume Optimization
- Baseline Remedial Strategy Report
- Short-Term Injection Test Report

The files requested are key or representative basemaps and numerical model data sets used in the preparation of these reports. Specifically, we would like to obtain drawing files with layers including the recently installed and proposed wells. Presumably, related tables containing well constructions and well screen elevations will be included. Also, please provide GeoTrans with a representative ASCII data file from a baseline groundwater modeling run performed as part of the South Plume optimization. This data file should be complete enough so that GeoTrans can replicate a modeling run. Ohio EPA has received only the conclusions that DOE has drawn from recent modeling scenarios performed to support the South Plume optimization. The purpose of this request is to obtain the actual data and modeling parameters that were used to support those conclusions.
