**Nov. 7, 1996** The Department of Energy (DOE) and Fluor Daniel Fernald will hold a workshop on the Recycling Methodology Plant 4 Case Study. The case study evaluates disposition options for structural steel from Plant 4 and other buildings at the Fernald Environmental Management Project (FEMP). A copy of the draft case study is available to the public in FEMP's Public Environmental Information Center (PEIC), 10845 Hamilton-Cleves Road. The meeting will be in the Alpha Building, Classroom B, 10967 Hamilton-Cleves Road, 7 p.m. to 9 p.m.

**Nov. 19, 1996** The Fernald Community Reuse Organization will meet in the Ross High School Media Center, 3425 Hamilton-Cleves Road, 7 p.m. to 9 p.m.

**Dec. 3, 1996** DOE and Fluor Daniel Fernald will hold a workshop to discuss current and future activities supporting the Waste Pits Remedial Action Project, including site improvements, rail upgrades and the Alternative Remedial Action Subcontracting Approach. The workshop will be in the Alpha Building, Classroom B, 7 p.m. to 9 p.m.

DOE submitted the Draft Remedial Action Work Plan (RAWP) for the Waste Pits Remedial Action Project to U.S. EPA and Ohio EPA on Oct. 18, 1996, for review and comment. The document is available for public inspection in the PEIC.
