The purpose of this letter is to formally approve the modified list of analytes that DOE proposed to be deleted from the annual RCRA groundwater monitoring program. The analytes removed from the list are those which have never been detected above their respective FRLs even in wells that are close to the source of contamination. We learned during a telephone call with Kathi Nickel that field parameters (such as temperature, conductivity, pH, etc) were inadvertently omitted and that it is DOE's intention to continue to include field parameters in this sampling program.
