The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) has completed its review of the United States Department of Energy's (U.S. DOE) clarification of response to U.S. EPA's comments on the final design of the On-Site Disposal Facility (OSDF) and leachate conveyance system.

U.S. DOE has adequately addressed U.S. EPA's previous comments. The calculations provided have adequately resolved original comment #4 by demonstrating that the post-development discharge rate of storm water runoff from the OSDF watershed will not exceed the predevelopment discharge rate.
