New Public Forum Features Tour of Fernald On-site Disposal Facility

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) and Fluor Daniel Fernald invite you to attend a new public forum -- the monthly Cleanup Progress Briefing -- on Sept. 9, 6 p.m. The briefing is intended to:

- update stakeholders regularly on current remediation projects;
- preview activity scheduled for the near- and long-term, as appropriate; and
- address specific issues and concerns regarding Fernald cleanup.

DOE and Fluor Daniel Fernald will begin with a detailed update of all major Fernald cleanup projects, then host a bus tour of the On-Site Disposal Facility site so stakeholders can see construction progress firsthand. The meeting will be held at the Alpha Building, 10967 Hamilton-Cleves Hwy., Harrison, Ohio.

The monthly briefings will be held at 6 p.m. on the second Tuesday of each month (locations to be announced) and will feature topic(s) of the stakeholders' choice.
