Dear Mr. Reising:

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) has completed its review of the United States Department of Energy's (U.S. DOE) Waste Acceptance Criteria (WAC) report for the Area 1 Phase 1, east impacted stockpile.

The report presents the results twenty-five additional soil samples collected from the pile and split with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency to determine if the material meets the WAC for the disposal cell.

The sample results indicate the material will meet the WAC for the disposal cell.

Therefore, U.S. EPA approves the placement of the east stockpile material into the disposal cell when all cell construction is certified complete and ready for material acceptance.
