The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) has completed its review of the United States Department of Energy's (U.S. DOE) Project Specific Plan (PSP) for sampling the Area 1, Phase 1 (A1,P1) west impacted soil stockpile.

This PSP provides a plan to further characterize the soils in the west impacted soil stockpile to assess whether they meet the waste acceptance criteria for the on-site disposal facility.

The PSP adequately presents an approach for evaluating the soils to meet the WAC.

Therefore, U.S. EPA approves the PSP for the A1,P1 west impacted soil stockpile.
