Draft Operable Unit 3 (OU3) Maintenance/Tank Farm Complex Implementation Plan for Above-Grade Decontamination and Dismantlement (D&D) and the Draft OU3 Sewage Treatment Plant Complex D&D Implementation Plan These plans identify project-specific demolition activities for each complex. The Department of Energy (DOE) submitted the Maintenance/Tank Farm Complex Implementation Plan on Feb. 26 and the Sewage Treatment Plant Complex Implementation Plan on March 2 to the U.S. and Ohio Environmental Protection Agencies for a 60-day review period.

Draft Waste Pit Remedial Action Project (WPRAP) Remedial Design Package The three-volume *Remedial Design Package* addresses the design of International Technology (IT) Corporation's waste processing equipment/facilities and IT's plans for waste excavation from Operable Unit 1 (i.e., six waste pits, Burn Pit, Clearwell, etc.). DOE submitted the package to the regulators for a 60-day review period on March 5.
